A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE BAKERY, CONFECTIONERY, TOBACCO WORKERS AND GRAIN MILLERS INTERNATIONAL UNION IN THE FIGHT AGAINST MONDELEZ INTERNATIONAL INC., OUTSOURCING LOCAL JOBS OF AN ATLANTA NABISCO PLANT TO MEXICO; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, The Bakery, Confectionery, Tobacco Workers and Grain Millers International Union ("BCTGM") is a modern union with old-fashion values. The BCTGM represents working men and women at some of the best known companies throughout the U.S. and Canada.; and

WHEREAS, the primary goal of the BCTGM is bring economic and social justice in the workplace to all workers throughout North America; and

WHEREAS, Mondelez International, Inc., is one of the world's largest snacks companies that includes Oreo, Chips Ahoy, Triscuit, Belvita, Nabisco, and Trident; and

WHEREAS, Mondelez International Inc., proposes to close Nabisco plants in cities such as Atlanta, Chicago, and New Jersey and outsource jobs to Mexico; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA GEORGIA, that the Atlanta City Council stands with the Bakery, Confectionery, Tobacco Workers, and Grain Millers International Union (BCTGM) and the employees of Atlanta's Nabisco Plant urging Mondelez International Inc., to reconsider closing Atlanta's Nabisco Plant and outsourcing jobs to Mexico.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that the Atlanta City Council and the Office of Municipal Clerk will transmit copies of the resolution to the Bakery, Confectionery, Tobacco Workers, and Grain Millers International Union and Modelez International, Inc.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions and parts of resolution in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
